

CHARGING AUXILIARY BATTERY VIA SHORELINE

1. Place inverter switch in **POWER SAVE** (up) position.



2. Plug the shoreline power cord into the port located on the exterior of the vehicle.



The inverter will power the outlets and charge the auxiliary battery in this setting

NOTE – The vehicle should be plugged in every night to keep the auxiliary battery fully charged.

PREPARING TO LEAVE FOR AN EVENT / MAINTAINING AUXILIARY BATTERY AT AN EVENT

1. Unplug the shoreline power cord.



2. Place inverter switch in **OFF** (middle) POSITION and wait 10 seconds.
3. Place inverter switch in **POWER ON** (down) position.



4. Turn vehicle on.
 - a. Drive to event.
 - b. Park.
 - c. Turn vehicle off.
5. If the inverter alarm sounds (beeping), this indicates low voltage in the auxiliary battery.
 - a. Start the vehicle to maintain the system functionality.

NOTE – The vehicle alternator is not intended to charge the auxiliary battery to full charge at an event. It is intended to maintain the existing charge.

DISCLAIMER – The inverter and auxiliary battery system is designed to power the freezer(s), mini-fridge, LED ceiling lights, & POS system. Adding any additional loads will affect functionality.
